- 3. All Federal and State firearms laws and regulations apply. The winner must pass any, and all, legally required background checks to claim a firearm. We will inform you of our FFL contact information. If you wish to have the prize transferred to your own FFL, this will be at your expense.
- 4. You must be 21 to enter the raffle.
- 5. Depending on the prize won, and IRS regulations at the time of winning, your name and social security number may be required to be reported to the IRS as a taxable event.
- 6. The drawing will be held at 7 pm on December 12,2024 at the SR&PC Burt Schuldt Education Center, W765 Rowe Rd Sheboygan, WI 53083. The drawing is open to the public, but the winner need not be present to win.
- 7. Firearms will be awarded in the order listed on the ticket.
- 8. We will notify winners promptly. Winners have until March 1, 2025, to claim the firearm, or cash prize. Failure to do so will result in prize forfeiture.
